









Making Paper Roses



1.	What you need to get started: Paper strips cut lengthwise from A4 coloured paper approx 2 cm wide. Tacky Glue		
2.	Fold the paper strip in half down its length.		
3.	Beginning at one end start by rolling the paper into a finger tight coil for 2 or 3 cm. coil - with the fold uppermost.		
4.	Fold the paper back on itself to form a right angle.		
5.	Roll the base of the coil around the angle until it is in a straight line again.		
6.	Repeat stages 4 and 5 until you come to the final 2 or 3 cm.		
7.	Fold this end back on itself fully and turn the work upside down.		
8.	Add spots of glue into the centre hollow, and secure the paper flap.
