

Make a Note

Desktop Notelet Stand

What you will need to recreate this project:

*Loose paper block – 9 cm square

Card to create stand & carrier

Tacky Glue

Super Sticky (red line) tape

* You will probably quite easily find a paper block in a pound shop, or The Works usually have them too. They come in various sizes, but the 9cm seems pretty standard?



How to assemble the project:

Another really easy one, as I have given you all of the actual size templates you will need at the end of these project notes.

So print off the templates, cut them out & transfer them to your card stock - usual format where black solid lines are where you cut, & blue perforated lines are where you score & fold.

I embossed only the front section of the carrier by using a small embossing folder, which was just slightly wider than the front panel. You will need to do the scoring & folding first, so you can position the embossing folder only on the front panel.

Using the main image, fold up the stand & glue the flap to the inside, where it will be concealed. Fold the carrier to form a partial box & glue the two little flaps to the inside of the base, this will make the carrier much sturdier.

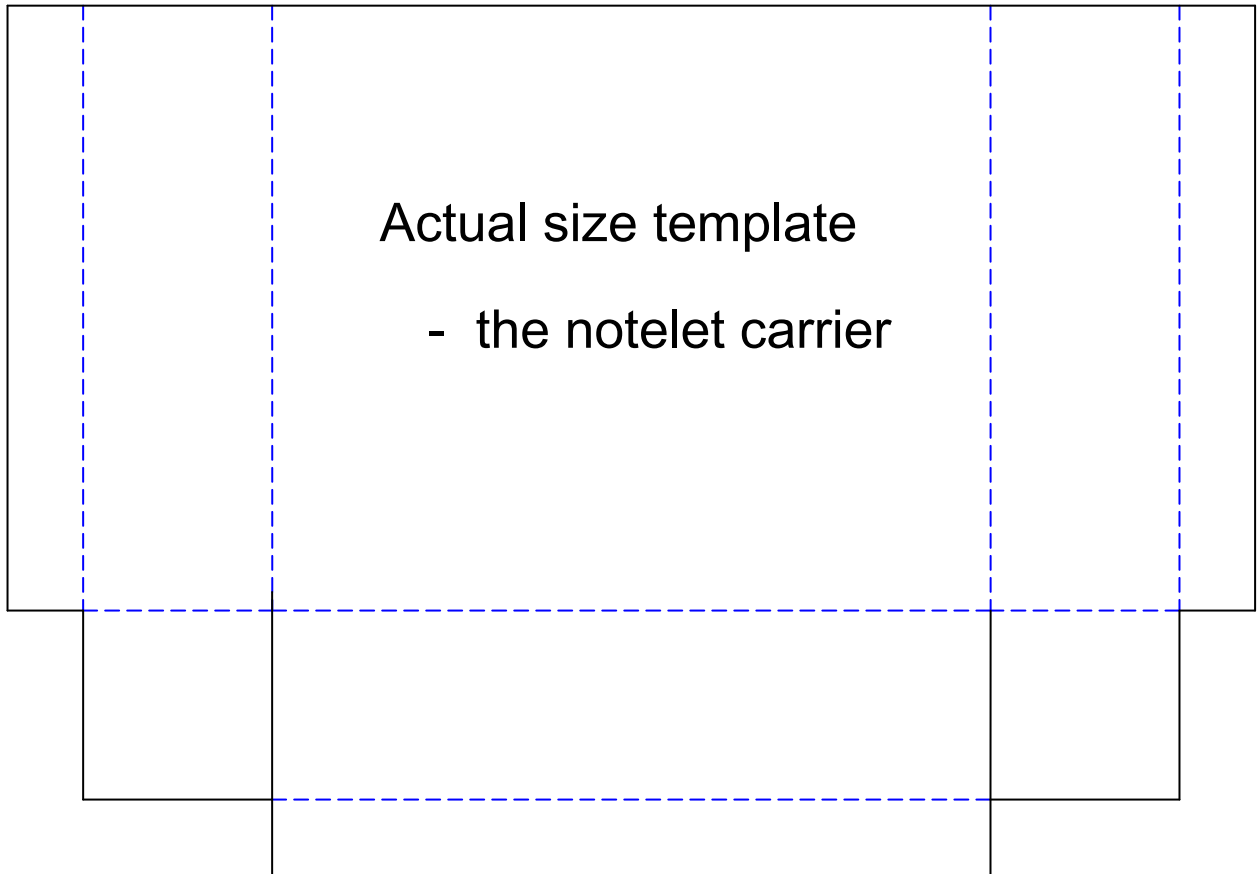
Next, use the ultra sticky tape around the three remaining flaps, & peeling only a little of the carrier paper on each, (fold it at right angles to the tape to make it accessible when the carrier is in position). Align the base of the carrier with the base line of the stand & when you are happy with

the position peel away the carrier paper & bond firmly.

Insert your block of paper & decorate if desired.
