Image 1: The current 'Honeycomb' paper collection goes into the second week coming up, so there is still a way to go with that.



So here is a decoupage card kit, along with a couple of oval toppers, featuring this particular little critter.

Image 5: One of those decoupage styles, which have proved to be more popular than I had anticipated, where I created the decoupage from the oval shape I had placed onto the original image.

Images 6 & 7: Here there are two versions of the same project now, the original & a second I create to take step by step pictures along the way for the project notes.

I uploaded a file last week that I had typed up on the gadget that I bought for a £5 to create shaker pouches with.

For this project you will need some way of sealing the pouch, but if you don't have anything else you could use a strong clear glue/glossy accents will work too!

Image 9: The second of the sheets I created using the little penguin, which fell into my shopping basket, this time without the little matching hat that I made for him.

So a layered card kit with an extra couple of mirrored oval mini toppers, to use elsewhere on your project.


