

# Twist & pop base card (with templates)

**What you will need to recreate this project:**

!4.8 cm square (6") card base 280 - 300gsm

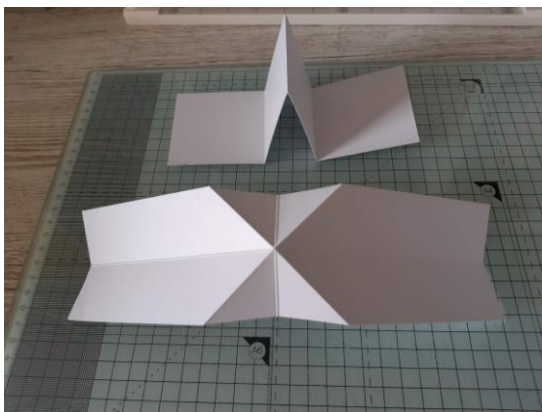
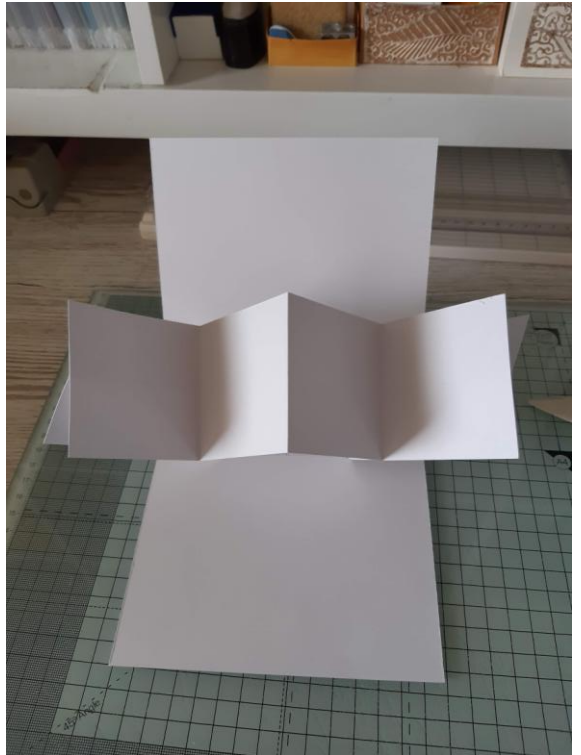
Sheet of matching card approx 160gsm (Copier card)

Adhesive & scissors

**Step by step:**

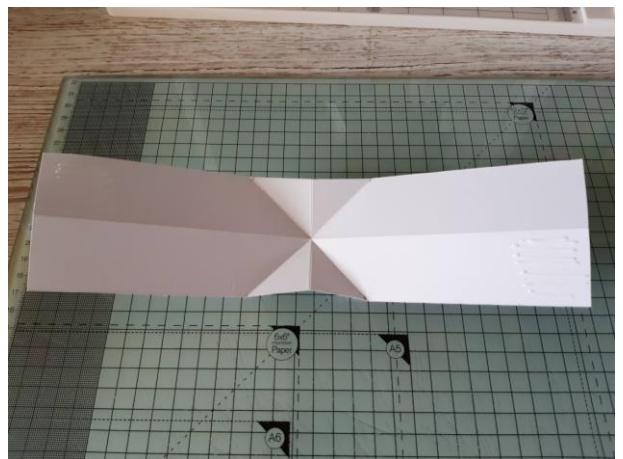
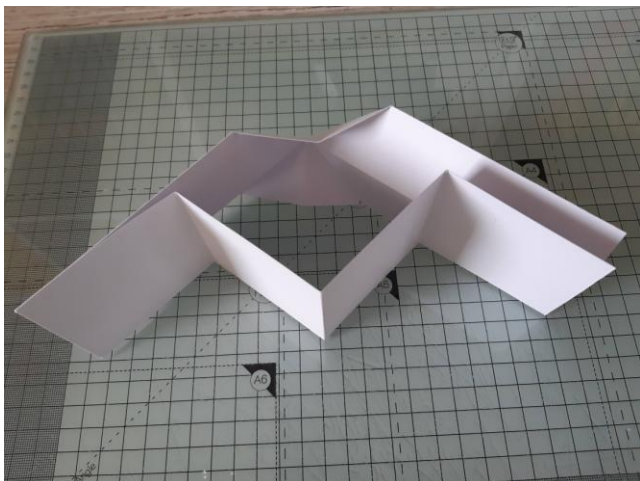
Cut out the templates on the final sheet of this hand out & transfer to your 160gsm card stock.

Fold & burnish the creases as shown in the picture below.

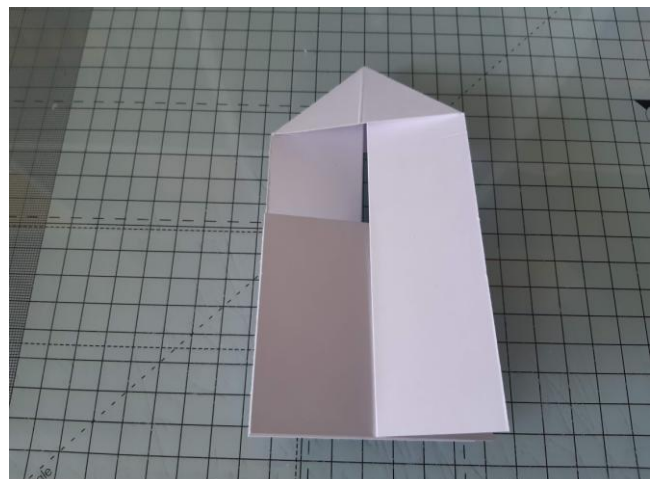


Apply adhesive to the top left & bottom right of the mechanism, as shown in the picture below.

Align & adhere the quarter fold piece directly on top of the mechanism as shown in the picture below.



Fold the piece up ready to insert inside of the card base exactly as shown in the picture below.



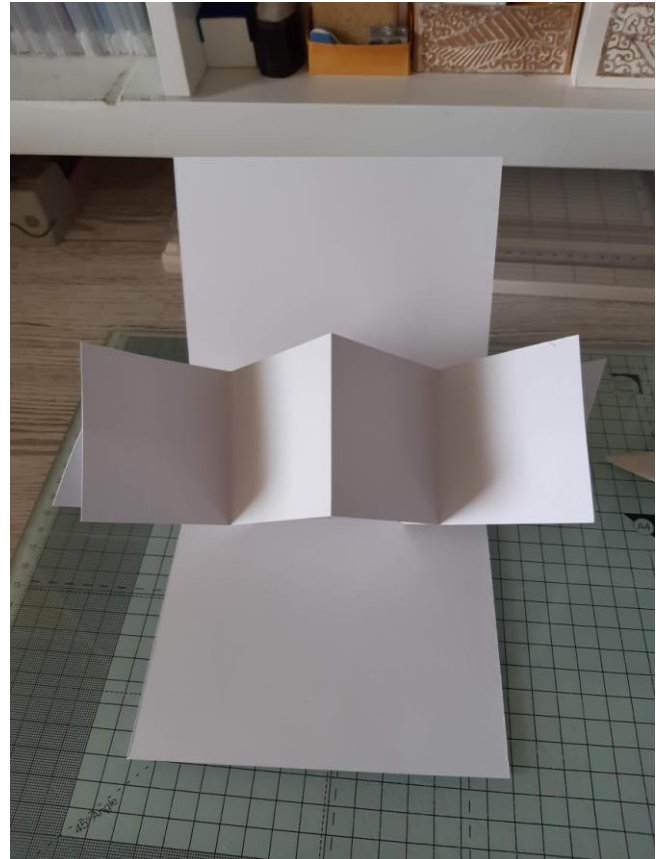
Apply adhesive to the pointed tip & align centrally inside of you square card base, just below the central crease line, as shown in the picture below.



Close the card & apply pressure until the glue sets, if using a wet glue.

Flip the work over & repeat with the other point, adhering it to the inside back of the card, though at this point the card will work either way.

Once the glue has set firmly open up the card & go ahead & decorate as you please, though I would advise you not to layer up the internal panels, as the card will simply become too bulky.
